- **Shoparoo:** It's so simple even I can do it. Look up Shoparoo on your smartphone, download the app, answer some easy questions (you can choose to be anonymous) then shop! Within 2 weeks of your shopping at stores like Raley's, Target, WalMart, Trader Joe's, even Berkeley Bowl - take a picture of your receipt through the Shoparoo app and submit it. Items that can be picked up, WORKING OR NOT! Televisions, monitors, fax machines, desk-top copiers, telephones, vacuum cleaners, keyboards, mice, networking equipment, wires and cords, household phones, medical equipment, video games, computers, calculators, cell phones, printers, scanners, laptops, power tools, small appliances, stereo systems, refrigerators, washers and dryers...and more. All electronics are recycled locally in California.

Summer Homework - Save Those Drink Pouches!

Over the summer, please start collecting empty juice pouches! (Capri Sun, Minute Maid, Hansons, Kool-Aid, etc.). We are kicking off a recycling/fundraising campaign in September, and your contribution can help us earn funding for school programs AND reduce waste.

Simply squeeze out any leftover liquid, remove the straw, and flatten the pouch. Bring your collection back to school in a sealed zip-top bag. (No need to open the pouch and rinse it out.) Storing the pouches in a zip-top bag will keep out ants and contain any leaks.


