

LdV Alum Appearing at Sac Theatre Company LdV families and friends are invited to see LdV alum Alexander DeNuzzo appearing on stage in the Sacramento Theatre Company's world-premier musical rendition of the Donner Party, playing Wednesdays-Sundays now through May 14th. The play tells the story of the ill-fated Donner Party's attempts to cross the Sierras and reach Sutter's Fort in 1846. This world-premier musical aims to make the story accessible to modern audiences in a contemporary way, similar to the way the story of the American Revolution has been revived in Hamilton. This new telling of the Donner Party's tale is a celebration of life and love even in the darkest times. Margaret Rose, one of the new musical's co-creators says, "Ultimately it's not a story about how half of the group died. It's about how half of the group lived.'

Alexander (Tommy Reed) first began performing at LdV in 2008 as a kindergartner in the after-school On Stage program. In addition to numerous On Stage performances, Alex also appeared as Malvolio in the Da Vinci Players 2016 production of Twelfth Night. Alex has also performed with local community theater groups including Runaway Stage, Theater One, and the Sacramento Theater Company. In 2016 Alexander joined the STC's Young Professionals Conservatory, a rigorous training program for students ages 12-18 who are interested in pursuing careers in theatre. You may have previously seen Alex on stage at STC in Pocahontas, Curtains Up, James and the Giant Peach, The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe. The Winter's Tale, and Disnev's Mulan Jr. Alex would like to thank LdV's Cynthia Speakman (On Stage) and Ellen Chapman (Da Vinci Players) for all their support and encouragement.

All hours (on & off campus) must be recorded on the monthly Tally Sheet and must be documented by: signing in and out (on campus in the front office, at a class or committee meeting, or with the supervisor of a work event); OR a blue verification card (available in the front office) signed by the teacher, class manager, or person overseeing your work hours. Blue verification cards must be attached to the corresponding Tally Sheet (verification cards turned in separately will not be counted); OR the authorized signature line on the Tally Sheet must be signed by the teacher, class manager or person overseeing your work hours.

- 20 hours completed by January 31st of the current school year.
- All parent hours completed and documented by May 15 of the current school year.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to attend all class meetings.

TALLY SHEETS: keep a copy of your Tally Sheets at home for your own reference

- One Tally Sheet per family per month unless there are two households where the child(ren) live.
- Tally Sheets are sent home monthly with the weekly PTC newsletter. (They are also available in the front office).
- Tallies are due the 5th of the following month, and no later than two months following participation.
- Updates of parent hours will be given out throughout the school year. Families are encouraged to find ways to get their hours, but if you need help, please feel free to contact the School Community Liaison (SCL).
- In addition to your family, work may be done by any person over 18 who does <u>not</u> have children enrolled at LdV. No person can be paid or compensated to perform parent hours.

IN-CLASS PARTICIPATION

- In-class volunteers must have a current TB (negative) test on file with the SCL. Tests are "good" for four years. A current, cleared SCUSD Sex Offender Check Authorization or fingerprints on file with the district.
- If you are unable to work in the classroom during your designated time, YOU must arrange for a substitute and inform the teacher or class manager.
- Do not bring siblings to class when you are working.
- Field trip drivers must have a current TB (negative) test on file with the SCL and fingerprints on file with the district.




