Send me to school if...

- I haven't taken any fieverreducing medicine for 24 hours, and I haven't had a fever during that time.
- I haven't thrown up or had any diarrhea for 24 hours.



Keep me at home if...

- I have a temperature higher than 100 degrees even after taking medicine.
- I'm throwing up or have diarrhea.
- My eyes are pink and crusty.

If you keep me home, remember to call my school immediately to report my absence!



Call the doctor if...

- I have a temperature higher than 100 degrees for more than two days.
- I've been throwing up or have dianthea for more than two days.
- I've had sniffles for more than a week, and they aren't getting bettar
- I still have asthma symptoms after using my asthma medicine (call 9ft iff m having trouble breathing after using an inhaler);

Be sure to get a note from the doctor and bring it to my school!


